

## **IIHF Transfer Information**

**Limited Transfer** - is for 1 season or the length of the parent(s) work visa

**Unlimited Transfer** - they moved here permanently. If they go back to their former country, they will need to do an IIHF with their old Federation because the playing rights are with Hockey Canada

### **1. For all of the Int'l transfers, we require the documents listed immediately below.**

- Player Registration form (PCAHA form recommended)
- Passport
- Application for Player Movement (if player played previously in another country)
- Birth Certificate
- Proof of Canadian status (Canadian Citizenship card, passport)
- Proof of residence (2 pieces)

**as well as, the required documents under the specific transfer type:**

### **2. Unlimited International Transfers (Canadians returning home who have played abroad)**

- Letter of Approval – IIHF International Transfer or US to Canada letter of approval for Minor)
- IIHF - Unlimited Transfer Card Request Form – (not required if US-Canada transfer)
- Letter from parents – requesting unlimited transfer – saying that the whole family has moved back to Canada

## **Registration of Players – Non-Canadian Born**

### **3. Permanent Resident of Canada:**

- IIHF Letter of Approval - International Transfer (USA – US to Canada letter of approval for Minor)
- IIHF - Unlimited Transfer Card Request Form – (not required if US-Canada transfer)
- Permanent resident card or proof that permanent resident status has been applied for
- Letter from parents – requesting unlimited transfer – saying that the whole family has moved to Canada permanently

### **4. Work Visa:**

- IIHF Letter of Approval – International Transfer (USA – US to Canada letter of approval for Minor)
- Copy of parent's work visa
- Copy of player's visa and passport
- Proof of primary medical coverage (BC Services card)
- Letter from parents requesting permission to participate while residing in Canada
- Letter of support from New Association
- Letter of support from District (PCAHA)

### **5. International Students:**

- IIHF Letter of Approval – International Transfer (USA – US to Canada letter of approval for Minor)
- Letter of support/non-support from the association the player registered with in the previous association
- Letter of support/non-support from the association the player is registered with for the current season
- Copy of passport
- Copy of Study permit
- Confirmation of school registration for current season
- Proof of primary medical coverage (BC Services card)
- Letter from parents requesting permission to participate
- Letter of support from homestay parents if player's parents are not with him in Canada
- Letter of support from District (PCAHA)
